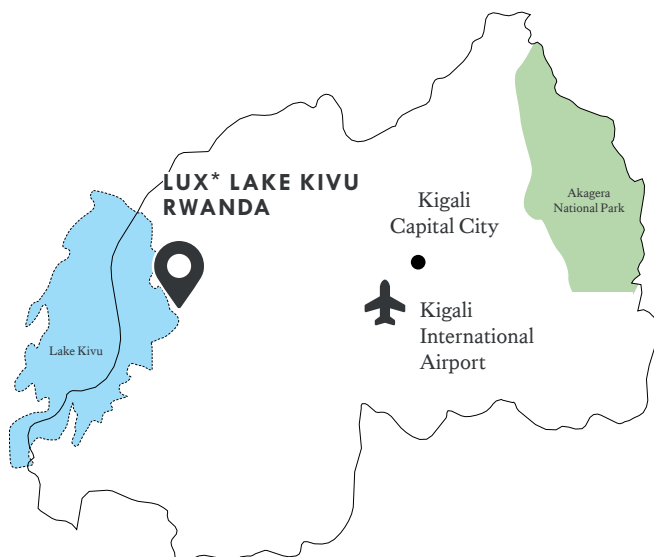

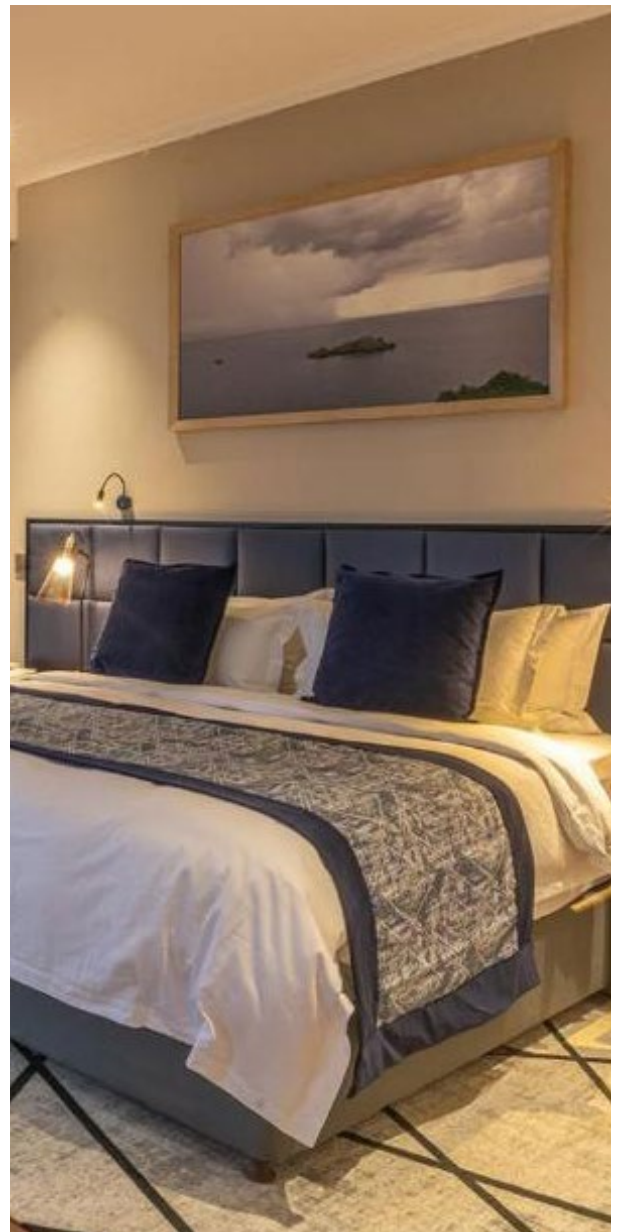

### ON THE WATER

#### Lanterns on Kivu

Out on the lake at dusk with local fishermen, their lamp-lit boats scattered across the water like stars.

#### The Island Run

A private boat journey to Lake Kivu's surrounding islands.

#### First Light on the Lake

A guided kayak at dawn, when the mist still sits on the water and the hills haven't woken up yet.

#### Sundowner on the Water

A private dusk cruise with chilled drinks and small plates as the sun drops behind the Congo hill.

#### Napoleon Trek

A guided trek up Napoleon Island, either early morning or timed to arrive as thousands of fruit bats lift from the trees in one sweeping, unforgettable mass.

#### From Cherry to Cup

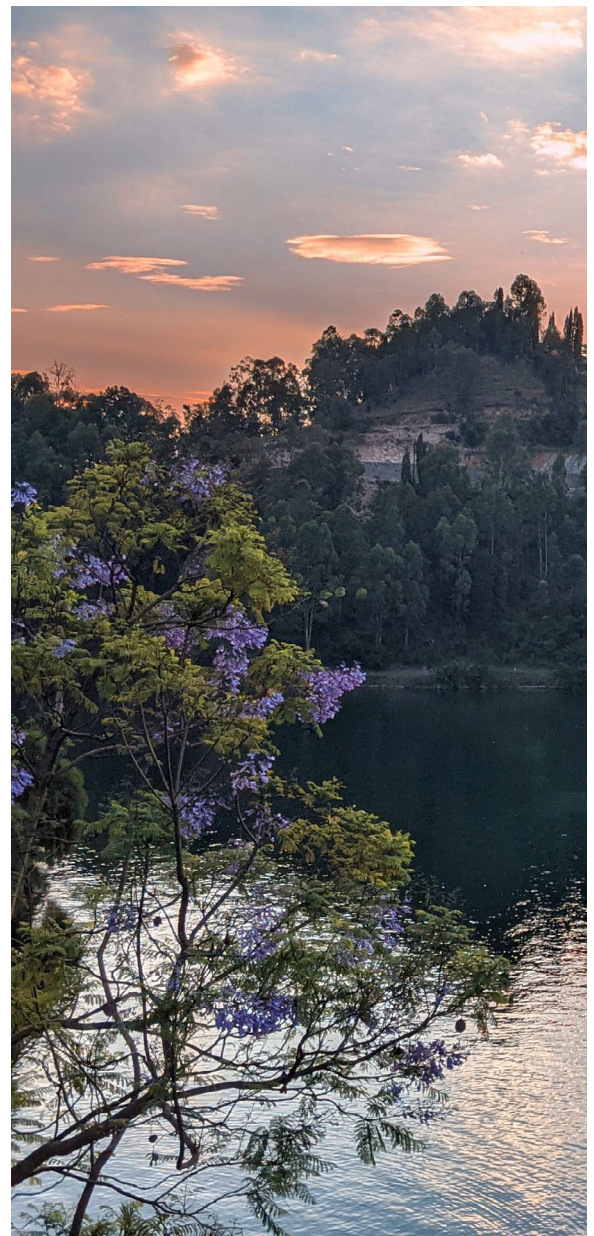
A half-day at a nearby coffee plantation - walking the rows, watching the washing process and cupping Rwanda's finest with the people who grew it.

#### The Congo-Nile Walk

A guided section of the world-famous trail, threading through villages and terraced hillsides along the lake's edge.

## EXTRAORDINARY EXPERIENCES

### INTO THE WILD

#### A day in Nyungwe Forest

Chimpanzee trekking and a 160-metre suspension walkway hanging 70 metres above the forest floor.

#### The Gorilla Morning

A full-day excursion to Volcanoes National Park for mountain gorilla trekking. One hour with a gorilla family that stays with you for life.

#### Birdwatcher's Kivu

An early-morning guided birding session in the Nyungwe forest. Over 200 species. One specialist guide. No rush.

### CULTURE & COMMUNITY

#### The Fisherman's Morning

A morning on the water with local fishermen - learning how they read the lake and bring in the catch. A real exchange, not a tour.

#### The Intore

An intimate performance of Rwanda's ancient warrior dance, followed by a conversation about what it means and where it comes from.

#### The Environment Museum

Located 3-5 min from the hotel.

#### The Bisesero Genocide Memorial

Learn more about the battle of Bisesero, known as the "hill of resistance".

### AT THE TABLE

#### The Garden Table

A chef's table in nature. Every course explained, every ingredient grown steps away.

#### Roots & Recipes

A Rwandan cooking session with the kitchen team using market produce and traditional recipes. Learn the dish. Eat the dish.

### STILLNESS

#### Sunrise Practice

Daily yoga and breathwork on the lake terrace as the mist lifts. Included in the stay.

#### The Floating Hour

A private raft on the lake. A book, a cold drink, the hills all around. Nothing else scheduled.
